

Is Total Defence still relevant?

- * Today, Singapore faces an increasingly complex and dangerous world. Geopolitical tensions and terrorism threaten to disrupt our economy, supply chains and multicultural harmony. Hybrid threats such as cyberattacks and disinformation operations can undermine our peace, security and unity.
- Total Defence, as a shared responsibility where every one of us has a role, provides a whole-of-nation framework to deal with these multifaceted threats.

















Are We Ready for Disruptions?

- TD has rallied Singaporeans together to face challenging national crises in the past, such as the 2008 global financial crisis and COVID-19. In a world often divided by intolerance and self-interest, all pillars of our Total Defence have stood strong and strengthened as a result of these stress tests.
- * As Singapore faces evolving threats and challenges, such as supply chain disruptions, water or power shortage, cyber attacks, our Total Defence will again be tested.


Exercise SG Ready

Within the Singapore Armed Forces (SAF), units tested their Business Continuity Plans (BCP) and identified areas of improvement to keep Singapore and the SAF strong and ready in times of disruptions.







Exercise SG Ready 2025

* This year, ESR will run from 15 to 28 Feb 2025. Co-led by the Ministry of Defence and Energy Market Authority (EMA), with a focus on power disruption and cybersecurity, it aims to:

Strengthen education of what to do in a power disruption.




Strengthen businesses' resilience against cyber attacks.






Exercise SG Ready 2025



Inaugural coordinated phishing exercise in collaboration with Singapore Business Federation, Nexus, and GovTech.



Integration with Whole-of-Government (WOG) Preparedness Programmes e.g., MTI-EMA will launch energy education and engagement strategy for the public.



Stronger businesses' participation across industries. Public and private sector organisations will test and execute organisational contingency plans through simulated power outages.



First simulated MRT power outage and escape shaft exercise involving youths, public and grassroots.




